



Police discover infant remains at burned Pa. home

SYKESVILLE, Pa. (AP) - Police investigating a house fire in Sykesville, Pennsylvania found the remains of an infant and were searching for the woman who had rented the house.

The fire that destroyed the home was reported early yesterday morning and the infant's remains were found about an hour later. An autopsy was scheduled to determine the cause of death.

Authorities were searching today for Joey Lynn Offutt, who rented the home. Police believe the 33-year-old woman was driving a red 1994 Saturn coupe with Virginia license plates and visible damage on its hood.

Offutt was declared a missing person and was entered into the National Crime Information Center database.

The Pennsylvania fire marshal is investigating the blaze.
